I. Text

II. Purpose

To help the beginning teacher in technical areas such as:

- A. Making topics interesting
- B. Building relationships with students
- C. Gestures, mannerisms, etc.
- D. How to endear students to you
- E. Classroom control mastery

III. Projects

- A. Read the book *The Art of Teaching* in its entirety and write a two-page summary of each section (II-V= 8 pages) .
- B. Read the book *The First Days of School* in its entirety and answer questions. Questions will be asked on tests. These questions will be provided for you.

IV. Tests

- A. There will be four tests over your notes and over *The First Days of School*:
 - 1. Test 1 - Lectures 1-4, Sections A-B book questions
 - 2. Test 2 - Lectures 5-7, Section C book questions
 - 3. Test 3 - Lectures 8-10, Section D book questions
 - 4. Test 4 - Lectures 11-12, Section E book questions
- B. There will be one cumulative final exam. **NOTE: You cannot take the final exam until you have sent in all of your projects.**



V. **Grading:**

Requirements for Classes
