III. Course Requirements

Online lectures must be listened to in their entirety. Tests will be given according to the scheduled lectures above and must be taken before proceeding to the next lecture. A final examination will follow all the lectures and will be comprehensive in nature over all the material.

IV. Projects

- A. Read chapters 1-35 of *Exploring the Scriptures* and answer all the book questions. These questions will need to be re-typed along with the answers and turned in as a project. Book questions will be asked on each test according to the breakdown above.



- B. Read each book of the Old Testament in its entirety and write a one-page summary on the theme of each book. This will need to be one page for every Old Testament book and be sure to include whether you read each book entirely.
- C. These projects are due *prior* to the taking of your final examination. The final will not be given until all projects are submitted in full.

V. Grading

Requirements for Classes
